History of the DRH Movement

DRH is an abbreviation for "Den rejsende Højskole", which is Danish and means "The Traveling Folk High School". The first DRH school started in Denmark in 1970. In the first 10 years, thousands of young people went traveling to all parts of the world and met with people from all walks of life. As a natural consequence of meeting fellow human beings, of whom many lived under poor and unacceptable conditions, the endeavor began to minimize the gap between rich and poor.

Every year around 800 Development Instructors train themselves at one of the 13 DRH Training Centers around the world in order to take up a position offered at one of Humana People to People's projects in Africa, Asia or Central America. A truly international and unique movement of people commitment to develop the world as well as developing them-



History of YID

Yunnan Institute of Development started in 2001 in Yuxi. It is a non-profit, non-formal educational Institute, approved by the Provincial Education Department.

Since the start YID has trained hundreds of people in development. These people have taken active part in development programs in Yunnan, and several have used the possibility to work abroad, e.g. in India, Zambia and Namibia. All the projects are run by HUMANA People to People.

The staff is international, and the participants come from all over China and from countries in Europe or Asia.

YID is one of thirteen training centers for Development Instructors. The training centers are located in eight different countries on four continents: Europe, USA, Africa and Asia.

YID rents buildings at the campus of our partner-school. Our foreign participants live inside the campus, the Chinese participants rent houses 5-10 minutes from the Institute. When working in the project you will have base in one of our DI-houses in the area.
